

**INURNMENT LICENSE AND AGREEMENT  
OF  
THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF THE HOLY COMMUNION**

This Inurnment License, granted and agreed to this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_ by and between The Episcopal Church of the Holy Communion of University City, St. Louis County, Missouri, a religious corporation and a parish of the Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Missouri, the Licensor

hereunder, and \_\_\_\_\_, of \_\_\_\_\_, the Licensee hereunder,

**WITNESSETH:**

1. The Licensor agrees to accept for inurnment in its Columbarium in the Church Building such cinerary urn as previously approved, containing the remains refined by fire, of the Licensee or of the licensee's deceased.
2. The Licensor agrees to cause said cinerary urn to be sealed and entombed in Columbarium Niche No. \_\_\_\_\_ in the Church columbarium, and to have engraved on the brass face plate the name and dates of birth and death, of the Licensee or the Licensee's deceased, as follows:

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3. The Licensor shall have full and complete control over said cinerary urn once it has been so sealed and entombed.
4. The Licensor shall permit the Licensee and all friends and members of the family of the deceased, and all others properly presenting themselves, to visit said Columbarium at will. If the building area in which the Columbarium is located is locked, it shall be opened upon request at all reasonable times.
5. It is the intention of the Licensor to maintain the Columbarium in good repair in perpetuity. However, in the event said Columbarium should be destroyed by fire, cyclone, earthquake or other Act of God and not be rebuilt, or in the event it shall be torn down or otherwise dealt with so that it no longer constitutes a portion of a church building of the Protestant Episcopal Church, then the Licensor at its sole discretion may cease to operate its said Columbarium as such. In that event the Licensor will cause said cinerary urn, if it then exists, along with all the other existing urns entombed therewith to be removed and suitable reburied or re-entombed at some lawful cemetery or burial place in the City of county of St. Louis, Missouri, of the licensor's own choosing. Licensee hereby agrees to hold Licensor harmless against any damage or expense as a result of the occurrence of any Act of God described herein.
6. In consideration of the grant of this license, the Licensee agrees to notify the Licensor, or cause it to be notified, of the death of the deceased and there-upon, or with the signing of this agreement, to select such cinerary urn as furnished by the Licensor or approved by it. If the Licensee so desires, the Licensor will send the urn it provides or approves to the undertaker or crematory selected by the Licensee.

7. The Licensee agrees to furnish the Licensor, or cause it to be furnished, before the interment of cinerary urn, a copy of the cremation certificate issued by the undertaker or crematory covering the inurnment of the cremated remains.
8. In consideration of the reservation of said Columbarium Niche No. \_\_\_\_\_ and the conduct of the inurnment or service under this license by a member of the Episcopal Clergy, the Licensee agrees to pay to the Licensor:
 

\$375 – to include: registration, reservation of the specific niche, a special urn and an engraved name plate.
9. The Licensee shall also bear all direct costs incidental to cremation, funeral director expenses, and actual inurnment.
10. There shall be no inurnment or memorial service on the church premises without its being conducted by a member of the clergy of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America.
11. This License is not transferable. After the cinerary urn has been sealed and entombed, upon application by the licensee or by any authorized applicant, said cinerary urn may be removed without refund of any amount paid by or for said Licensee and at the cost of said applicant, who shall likewise pay the cost of replacing the brass face plate.
12. Numbering and identification of the niches within the Columbarium shall be determined by licensor in accordance with Appendix A attached hereto.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF** the Licensor has caused this Inurnment License and Agreement to be duly signed and attested, and the Licensee has hereunto affixed his signature, all as of the day, month, and year first above written.
