

Youth/FaithQuest

FaithQuest continues to be an essential component of the youth program at Holy Communion, this year we changed our meeting time to the first and third Sunday Evening of each month.

I joined the staff in August of 2017 Youth leaders include: Markie Jo Crismon, Mary Bass and Scott Ragland.

The youth meet around 5:30 p.m. to eat dinner and socialize before playing a game for about 30 minutes. Indoor soccer and competitive tic-tac-toe are popular game options. We then migrate to the tower room to discuss scripture via storytelling, visualizations and reading aloud, often relating scripture to other stories or personal experience. After 20 minutes of scripture study, we play flashlight tag in the church for about 30 minutes. Average attendance is between eight and twelve youth participants.

A youth night out skating at the Forest Park Ice Rink was a big success in December. Many of the youth showed an interest in being more active in the community. This is an idea we are still exploring. Many youth also helped run booths at our fall festival, from games to popcorn and caramel apples.
